# **Appointment Training for female junior scientists**

By the end of the PhD-phase at the latest, the question of the further career path for young female scientists\* becomes increasingly important. Irrespective of the frequency with which potentially suitable professorships are advertised, for many the appointment procedure is a difficult, usually rather lengthy and emotionally demanding application process. This workshop sets in by introducing the appointment process step-by-step and familiarizing the participants with the procedures and requirements for appointment to both university and UAS professorships. The aim is to broaden the perspectives of the participants for the different types of professorships and for their own career prospects. The appointment training focuses on both a practical approach to authentic applications (directly on the participants' documents\*) as well as process information. Finally, the workshop focuses on the "audition" and here especially on the panel's interview. In addition to the self-presentation, the participants learn a lot about the different forms of the hearing process and get a deeper insight into the panel's discussion.
